VenInformado: a dynamic, multi-service digital platform for Venezuelan migrants & refugees in Peru

PROJECT GOAL

To contribute to improving the quality of life for the most vulnerable of the Venezuelan population in Peru, reducing the gap in access to information and promoting sustainable solutions for local integration through the VenInformado digital platform.

The political and economic crisis in Venezuela has subjected many to violence, persecution and limited access to health care and food, forcing more than 5.3 million to flee to surrounding countries in search of decent living conditions. According to the Brookings Institution, the Venezuelan refugee crisis has been the most underfunded in modern history.

Currently, there are more than 1 million Venezuelan refugees and migrants living in Peru, each with unique needs in regard to legal status, health, education, shelter and employment. The multiple lockdowns instituted by the Government of Peru since the declaration of the COVID-19 pandemic have exacerbated their already vulnerable circumstances, exposing them to income loss, malnutrition, abuse and stress.

Lutheran World Relief has had a permanent presence in Peru since 1979 and has been serving Venezuelan migrants since 2018. Lutheran World Relief developed the digital platform VenInformado to help connect the Venezuelan refugee and migrant population with critical, accurate information and personalized virtual legal, psychosocial and livelihoods assistance. With local partners Encuentros and CAPS providing implementation support, VenInformado has earned more than 10,000 followers on its social media sites and has handled over 11,000 diverse direct inquiries since its launch. EXPECTED RESULTS

- **4,000 individuals** will benefit from direct legal, psychosocial and/or livelihood support.
- **400 men/women** will receive seed grant funding and training for their small businesses.
- **100 men/women** will receive direct remote psychosocial or psychotherapeutic services.
