1. ORGANIZATION INTRODUCTION:

Corus International, as part of this pre-qualification process, is seeking companies capable of shipping and handling Corus Staffs' (US Employees "Expat" and Third Country National "TCN") HHE and UAB.

- 1- This is a highly specialized function, and the contractor must ensure and appreciate the importance of Corus Staff's HHE and UAB and ensure the greatest care in handling and shipping such personal effects either by air freight or Sea freight without damage or pilferage to shipment contents.
- 2- The contractor shall provide the door to door, or door to port services that cover the following countries but are not limited to:

5- The contractor must be able to provide managerial, labor personnel, material, and transportation that are necessary to pick up- loading- drop off activity as well as perform proper packing and safe storage of the HHE and UAB until shipped.

- 6- The contractor should provide detailed packing and weight certificates for both air freight and seas freight.

- 5- At least 3 references point of contact (phone, email, organization) supported by copies of orders or contracts.

Questions and Answers:

1. Question Received: Number of (annual) assignees that Corus currently has or expects to have.

Answer: It will depend on need basis; an estimation is not available at this time. Please provide your quote as per assignee for each destination.

2. Question Received: Do you have the most popular shipping routes?

Answer: Ocean and from/to:

USA all states to DRC- Kinshasa

USA all states to South Sudan capital

USA all states to Sudan capital

USA all states to Nepal capital

3. Question Received: In order to provide meaningful rates, we require an indication of assignee allowances both for sea and UAB shipments. (You make reference to a pallet for sea and a bag for air but give no sizes)

Answer: For HHE, it will be up to the weight limit of 7200 lbs.

For UAB, it will be 250 lbs. individual and 600 lbs. for family

4. Question: We also require an origin and destination to be able to provide DTD and DTP rates.

Answer: Please refer to page number 2 and 3 of the RFI for list of destinations for DTD and DTP. For now, we request a flat rate between country-to-country. Or please provide a quote as per your best-practiced origin and destination within a country.
